Collection Time for Children

All children should be collected before 2.30pm everyday. Some parents have been arriving upto 45 minutes after the 1.5 hour collection period (1.00-2.30pm). Therefore, as of March the 15th parents will be charged an additional 150 QR per hour, per day for any length of time after 2.30pm.

Is your child getting enough sleep to develop fully?

We are having a number of children arriving to school still sleeping or are very tired. Medically your child should be having between the following number of hours every day.

> 2—4 years 10-12 hours 5-6 years 8-10 hours

It is scientifically known that sleep deprivation in small children can hinder in the development of the bodies systems and effect learning and behaviour even at this small age. Therefore we request that you build into your child's daily regime enough time for them to get a good nights sleep so they are prepared to undertake the next days activities.
